Monthly statistics: statistical summaries for the month of July 2019 will be available at our meeting.

Financial/Donations:

- We received our check for our LLSA funding in the amount of \$1419.00 (Local Library Services Aid--provided by the Governor and Legislature for public library systems and their services. Each of the public libraries in New York State that belongs to a public library system and that meets minimum standards set by the Education Department is entitled to receive this aid.)
- SALS sent along the figures for what our estimated fees will be for 2020: the total will be \$4,263.03 and the monthly fee will be \$355.25.
- We have received a few memorial donations for Dick Hickland, in the amount of \$220.

News/Issues:

- I have started to have a few people dropping in for my Information & Referral hours, and others have asked questions about it.
- Notary Public services are being used more frequently. The word has gotten around, and continues to spread.
- Our new website is very close to being ready to launch. We still have a bit more, relatively minor, behind-the-scenes work to do on it.

Programs:

- Summer programs going well. Lunch, Learn, & Play groups have been attending our programs when it fits their schedule. LL&P ends on Aug. 9th and our summer programming goes through mid-August.
